## A2 Waystage or elementary

At the elementary level, the candidates demonstrate an understanding of sentences and frequently employed expressions pertaining to areas of immediate significance, encompassing basic personal and familial information, local geography, and employment-related topics. Their communicative abilities extend to engaging in uncomplicated and routine tasks involving a straightforward exchange of information on familiar and routine matters. Furthermore, candidates can articulate, in simple terms, aspects of their background, immediate environment, and relevant subjects essential to their immediate needs. While they grasp the most commonly used English vocabulary and can construct simple sentences and questions, they may encounter challenges with comprehending or constructing extended or intricate sentences.

## **Tips for improvements**

- Build vocabulary by learning new words and phrases related to everyday and work-related situations.
- Practice using more complex sentence structures, such as conditional sentences and simple present/past/continuous tense.
- Focus on improving organisation and coherence in writing by using simple transition words and phrases.
- Work on improving listening skills by listening to longer and more complex audio materials, such as podcasts or lectures.
